

WRAG BARN - LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS

- Beyond any ditch, hedge or fence forming the boundary of the course.
- To the right of the 18th fairway marked by white posts.
- In the flowerbeds, or beyond the lawn, at the rear of the 18th green.
- On the practice ground to the left of the 1st fairway, marked by white posts.
- Over the ball stop fence to the left of the 2nd fairway.
- Over the hedge at the rear of the 11th green.

2. MOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 15)

- All stones in bunkers.
- All rakes should be left **IN** bunkers.

3. INTEGRAL OBJECTS (No Relief) (Rule 16.1)

- The bridges on the 6th & 12th, plus the stone bridge over the stream on the 17th hole.

4. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Free Relief) (Rule 16.1(a))

- All fixed sprinkler heads.
- All pathways on the course.
- Young trees identified by stakes.
- Ball stop fence to the left of the 2nd fairway.
- Wooden fencing on 8th.

5. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 16.1)

- A ball lying on the lawn to the rear of the 18th green **MUST** be lifted and played from the nearest dropping zone without penalty.
- A player must not play a ball from a 'wrong putting green' other than the hole being played. This includes the apron of the main green and temporary greens.
- All hoof marks on the 6th & 7th holes caused by horses on the bridleway.
- The Greenkeepers compound to the right of the 10th fairway, marked by blue posts.

6. OVERHEAD WIRES

- If a ball strikes the power lines at the 3rd hole, the player **MUST** disregard that stroke, abandon the ball and play another ball from the tee without penalty.

WARNING (PUBLIC FOOTPATH)

Whenever persons are crossing the course by public footpath a player shall not play towards them until they have reached a place of safety if the footpath crosses the 4th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 13th, 14th, & 18th fairways.

ETIQUETTE

Players are reminded that at all times they must observe golfing etiquette as outlined in Section 1 of the 'Rules of Golf'.

EXPECTED PACE OF PLAY

We hope you enjoy your round but please ensure you always keep up with the group ahead. 3 ball should manage 18 holes in 3 hours and 25 minutes and 4 balls in less than 4 hours.

Wrag Barn have adopted the *Ready Golf Policy*.

HEALTH & SAFETY

- A player must always ensure that it is safe to play a shot, before doing so.
- Golf shoes with spikes or soft spikes in good condition must be worn on the course at all times.
- Playing a tee shot at the 1st hole over the practice putting green is dangerous and not permitted.
